**CLIMATE PROJECT - REGIONAL AND GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE:
FROM THE PAST TO THE FUTURE.**

CALL CLIMATE 01/2019

The *CLIMATE Project coordination (CLIMATE - Regional and Global Climate Change: from the past to the future)* makes public the opening of two short-term positions for **Visiting Professor** in Niteroi city, Rio de Janeiro state, Brazil according to the Internationalization Institutional Program CAPES-Print nº. 41/2017, and other legal acts related to the CAPES-Print program, aiming to consolidate and strengthen the international cooperation between the *stricto sensu* Graduate Programs of UFF, Fluminense Federal University (<http://www.uff.br>) - Geosciences Geochemistry (<https://www.geoquimica-uff.com.br>), Ocean and Earth Dynamics (<http://www.dot.uff.br>), Geography (<http://www.posgeo.uff.br>), Marine Biology and Coastal Environments (<http://bmac.sites.uff.br>), Physics (<https://www.if.uff.br/pt/posgraduacao>) and associated international research centers.

1. PURPOSE

The present call aims to select two (2) Visiting Professors, attracting prominent international researchers in the areas of interest of the CLIMATE Project to provide short courses (Summer / Winter School) for students of the PPGs involved in this project, increasing the scientific and technological development of the participating programs and strengthening institutional cooperation.

The specific objectives of the Program are:

- 1.1 Promote integration between the different postgraduate programs involved in the CLIMATE Project;
- 1.2 Strengthen collaboration between researchers working in Brazil and abroad;
- 1.3 Assist in the process of internationalization of higher education and Brazilian science, technology and innovation;

2. THE SHORT-TERM COURSE

- 2.1 Selected applicants for Visiting Professor should provide a short course in the format of a Summer/ Winter School, with **maximum duration of 15 days**, focused on the central theme of the CLIMATE project;
- 2.2 The short term course should also include the participation of Brazilian professors and researchers from graduate programs associated to CLIMATE Project;
- 2.3 The short term course will be offered to students from graduate programs associated to CLIMATE Project, with the possibility of attending students outside these programs.

3. ELIGIBILITY

Candidate's eligibility conditions are:

- 3.1 to be professor or researcher with recognized competence in their area of activity;
- 3.2 to show relevant scientific production, preferably in the last five years;
- 3.3 to present a detailed short-term course syllabus to be offered, which shows compliance to the main thematic of the CLIMATE project;
- 3.4 to present an invitation letter by the main graduate program to which the candidate will be associated during the visiting period.

4. BENEFITS OFFERED TO VISITING PROFESSOR

4.1 These are eligible items within the scope of this Call for Visiting Professor in Brazil at UFF:

- a) international airfare ticket in economy class, round trip between the country of origin and Brazil;
- b) daily expenses to cover a maximum period of 15 days in Brazil, according with local standards.

4.1.1. CAPES and UFF will not reimburse airfare purchased outside the Program rules, will not cover changes fees and will not grant passage to others.

4.1.2. CAPES and UFF will not cover any costs other than those described in item 4.1, such as: health insurance, life insurance, accident insurance, among others. For this reason, it is recommended that the Visiting Professor acquire health and or life insurance, as there will be no reimbursement of any kind of medical expenses, due to personal injury or damage to third parties.

4.1.3. The Medical, Dental and Pharmaceutical Assistance of the foreigners in Brazil will be covered by the government program *Sistema Único de Saúde* (SUS), in accordance with the agreement signed between the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MRE) and the Ministry of Health in 25 of January 1994.

4.2. The corresponding benefits are defined by CAPES Ordinance No. 132, from August 18, 2016.

5. DOCUMENTS FOR APPLICATION

Application must be submitted **online** by the foreign candidate or by the guest Brazilian professor/graduate program (associate to the CLIMATE project) on the CLIMATE project website (<http://www.geoprint-uff.com.br>). The following documents are required (upload in PDF format):

- 5.1. Application Form, completed in the address above;
- 5.2. Updated *Curriculum Vitae*;
- 5.3. Invitation letter issued by the guest graduate program associate to the CLIMATE Project;
- 5.4. Proposal and Syllabus of the short-term course which will be offered.

6. ANALYSIS AND CLASSIFICATION OF APPLICATIONS

The applications will be reviewed by the committee designated to select the Visiting Professor in Brazil, approved by the coordination of the CLIMATE Project, evaluating the Proposals and Curriculum of the Candidates.

7. RESULTS AND RECONSIDERATION

The Selection Committee of the CLIMATE Project will disseminate the results on the website <http://www.geoprint-uff.com.br> according to the schedule set in item 8.

After results are published, requests for reconsideration may be submitted to the Selection Committee of Visiting Professor in Brazil of the CLIMATE Project using a proper form

- a. The reconsideration must be submitted within 48 hours after publication of the results;
- b. The Selection Committee will answer the reconsiderations in 5 working days.
